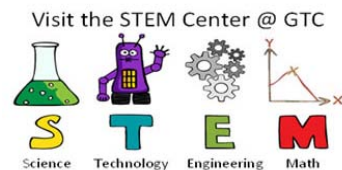


Georgia Cares
